Dear 8th grade student and family,

The Danaher Lynch Family Foundation is excited to announce the details of our Class of 2023 CEC Scholarship Program. This year will mark our 5th year of DLFF Scholarships and we are proud to say that our scholar family has grown to more than 75 students currently attending Conwell-Egan Catholic.

DLFF is a strong supporter of Catholic education in the Lower Bucks County area and we acknowledge the excellent educational experience that Conwell-Egan Catholic High School offers our community. Therefore, we are proud to continue our scholar's program by offering \$2,000 scholarships to 8th grade students who are selected through the DLFF application process.

Our founders, Tom and Patty Lynch believe that everyone has more potential than they realize. When reviewing applications to select the scholarship recipients, our team looks at the whole student. While commitment to academics is part of the selection criteria, we recognize that students can be successful in a variety of ways. Consideration is given to students who participate in both school and community programs, display a giving back mindset and demonstrate a variety of extracurricular interests.

DLFF offers three types of scholarships - the DLFF Community Scholarship, the DLFF Visual Arts Scholarship and the DLFF Performing Arts Scholarship. The Visual and Performing Arts Scholarship applications will be reviewed, and recipients selected by the CEC Fine Arts Department. If an applicant is not chosen as a Fine Arts Scholarship recipient, they may still be considered for a DLFF Community Scholarship. All DLFF scholarships are renewable for four years at Conwell-Egan Catholic High School if the recipient remains in good standing based on our DLFF Scholarship Policy located on our website.
